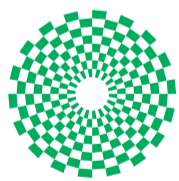

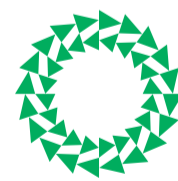

Grant Program Details

- Grants support studies at one of two Partner Academic Institutions:
 - Tel Aviv University's Buchmann-Mehta School of Music
 - Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance
- Grants are awarded on a one-year basis, with the opportunity to re-apply and renew for one additional year, as long as the grantee remains in strong academic standing.
- Grants cover full tuition, housing, a basic living stipend, and medical insurance for one academic year. Airfare to/from Israel, visa and application fees are not covered
- Opportunities for artistic collaborations, performances, and master classes through the program

We are closely monitoring the situation with the COVID-19 global pandemic in order to best inform and advise all our applicants.

Planning for the future might not be a first priority right now, but even in this moment it is essential to pursue opportunities for the future when this global challenge will hopefully pass.

Eligibility

- Greek Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Between 18 – 35 years old
- Must apply and be accepted into an Israeli Bachelors, Masters or Artist Diploma International Program at Tel Aviv University's Buchmann-Mehta School of Music or a Masters program at Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance.
- Eligible instruments/degree programs are according to the institution's academic program.

Application Requirements

Important: Candidates must apply to their academy of choice in addition to submitting the AICF Scholarship Program application.
